### **Inserting and typing text:**

- i insert text (and enter input mode)
- \$a append text (to end of line)
- ESC re-enter command mode
- J join lines

### **Cursor movement:**

- h left
- j down
- k up
- l right
- ^ beginning of line
- \$ end of line
- 1 G top of document
- G end of document
- <n>G go to line <n>
- ^F page forward
- ^B page backward
- w word forwards
- b word backwards

# **Deleting and moving text:**

- Backspace delete character before cursor (only works in insert mode)
- x delete character under cursor
- dw delete word
- dd delete line (restore with p or P)
- <n> dd delete n lines
- d\$ delete to end of line
- dG delete to end of file
- yy yank/copy line (restore with p or P)
- <n> yy yank/copy <n> lines

# Search and replace:

%s/<search string>/<replace string>/g

u undo :w save file :wq save file and quit ZZ save file and quit :q! quit without saving
